The University of Chicago Medicine Comprehensive Cancer Center is excited to announce a four-week summer internship for City Colleges of Chicago students to gain experience across cancer clinical research including regulatory management, data management, clinical research coordination, and quality assurance.

Clinical research is an important and rapidly growing industry focused on research conducted in human subjects. This industry is key in translating discoveries from the laboratory setting to clinical practice. This health career path allows you to make an impact on people now and the future of medicine.

Program Eligibility:

- Associate degree seekers at any City College of Chicago at time of application
- At least age 18 at start of program; no age cap
- Strong interest in a career in clinical research and the clinical research workforce
- Ability to commit to the full on-site four-week internship at 35 hours/week, and monthly enrichment activities during the academic year

Benefits:

- Hands-on, simulated experiences across the clinical research workforce
- Networking opportunities with faculty and staff at the University of Chicago
- Development of a culminating internship portfolio
- Opportunity to co-present an internship poster at the Annual Summer Research Symposium
- Monthly career development and skill-building workshops during academic year
- Access to communications about job postings and other opportunities
- Taxable stipend of **\$2,500** (with an additional \$250 for monthly academic year engagement)
